Did you know that the gift of life can also be the gift of hope to a patient in need? After your baby is born, the placenta (or afterbirth) is usually discarded as medical waste, but it can actually provide a precious gift.

Doctors can treat difficult-to-heal wounds such as diabetic foot ulcers, venous leg ulcers and burns using placental-based tissue as a protective barrier. This tissue can also be used in surgical procedures where complications are likely.

Donating is easy and poses no risk for you or your baby.

Mothers who deliver via Caesarean section with a participating physician, are eligible to participate in our placental donation program. Donation is:

SAFE. There is no risk. The priority remains delivery of a healthy baby, as the placenta is recovered as part of the afterbirth.

SIMPLE. Once you formally consent, you only need to answer a series of questions regarding your medical and social history, similar to those answered when giving blood.

PAINLESS. There are no additional procedures. A routine blood test done simultaneously with your admittance blood draw on the day of surgery.

FREE. There is no cost to you or your family.

**Dehydrated Human Amnion/
Chorion Allograft Case Examples**



A toddler presented with a partial-thickness scald burn on the face and the allograft was applied



A 4-year-old presented with a contact burn from a hot fire pit



At one week, the burn was progressing well to closure



Allografts were applied over all burn areas



At 2-4 weeks pigment was returning and resulted in an excellent treatment outcome



2 weeks after the allografts were applied, the burn on the hand was fully closed and hand range of motion was maintained
